### **2. Disclosure of Personal Data During the Study**

Your data will be treated confidentially and will not be disclosed to external parties.

### **3. Processed Personal Data**

During the study, the following personal data will be collected: research field, working organization, and role within the organization. The collection of data is based on the study's plan.

### **4. Legal Basis for Processing Personal Data**

The processing of your personal data is based on the legitimate interest of scientific research (Article 6.1.e of the General Data Protection Regulation, national law § 21 a).

### **5. Transfer of Personal Data Outside the EU/EEA**

No transfer of personal data to countries outside the EU/EEA will take place in this study.

### **6. Protection of Personal Data**

The processing of personal data in this study is carried out based on an appropriate plan, and the study has a designated responsible person. Only necessary information for the study's purpose will be stored in the register.

Directly identifiable information will not be collected, so participants can only be indirectly identifiable from the dataset. Identification would be possible only by combining information with data obtained from other sources, attempting to identify participants through such means.

Processed personal data will be safeguarded using usernames and passwords.



## **7. Processing of Personal Data After the Study Ends**

The research register will be anonymized by approximately December 2023, meaning all personally identifiable information will be permanently removed. This ensures that there is no way to revert to personally identifiable data, and no new data can be associated with the dataset using identifiable information.
